Classroom Management Policy

Expectations

- Always be ready to make music!
- All students are required to come into the classroom and sit down in their assigned seats with music and pencils ready to begin class.
- Arrive early to class to prepare music and materials needed. "To be early is to be on time, to be on time is to be late, and to be late is unacceptable" –Eric Jerome Dickey
- Treat teachers, equipment, and fellow musicians with respect. The golden rule: Treat others the way you want to be treated.
- Raise your hand when you have a question
- No food, drink (except water), or gum is allowed. All food and gum must be discarded before entering the room.
- Keep music in good condition

Sequence of Consequences

Depending on the circumstances:

- 1. Talk with teacher after class
- 2. Warning is given at a talk with teacher after class
- 3. Detention is given by teacher
- 4. Student's parents are called
- 5. Student is sent to the principal's office
- 6. Suspension, or appropriate consequence according to action
